Terry Galle, President called meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. and presided,

- Minutes. The minutes of the November 10, 2021 meeting were presented and read. The
 motion was made by Thomas Zdansky and seconded by Melvin Gay that the minutes of the
 November 10, 2021 meeting be approved. Following a discussion, the motion unanimously
 carried.
- 2. Public Comment Period. There was no audience. No one submitted a public comment.
- 3. Lateral G Status Report.
 - 3.1 County widening and improvement between east line of Block 28, GCIC and U.S. Highway 77/I-69. Manager Greenhill met with the County Commissioner and project engineer on December 7, 2021, at the project site to discuss project design. Surveying will begin today, December 8, 2021. Engineering design will be submitted in January 2022 for approval and once the plans are approved. Probably the project will be put out for bids in February 2022.
 - 3.2. County widening and improvement of segment between FM 1018 and Hidalgo Main Drain
 - a. Status. Manager Greenhill will attend the December 9, 2021 Willacy County Commissioners Court meeting to hear project update to be presented by Hidalgo County Drainage District #1's Manager, Raul Sesin. Manager Greenhill report at January 2022 meeting.
 - b. Consider and take action on any matters to finalize grant. No action required at this time.
- 4. TxDOT FM 1018 Improvement upgrade of drain crossings at Laterals G, G1 and C. Status report: Work has commenced. The contractor is supposed to install the two 5'x5' box culverts at the Lateral G crossing north of Los Mesquite Subdivision sometime in January or February 2022.

5. Lateral E, Lateral E-1, and Lateral E-2 in Share 2. Consider and take action to engage surveyor to prepare a description of the drains. No action

6. Equipment:

- 6.1 Godwin DCP 300 Pump Gate 630-L (Fred Gate). No change in status. The pump is still in the District's yard awaiting transportation to the pad by the dealer. Installation will take approximately one day. Payment will be made at that time.
- 6.2 Caterpillar 326 Long Reach Tentative delivery still January or February 2022.
- 7. Reports: Receive reports and make decisions respecting the subject of such reports including:

7.1 Manager:

- (a) Work accomplished since last meeting. Report presented. Equipment has been brought in for end of year maintenance.
- (b) Hidalgo-Willacy Joint Venture Drain Weir No. 4 failure: Hidalgo County Drainage District No. 1 has done nothing to remove the damaged weir—the debris are still in the drain channel. HCDD#1 has advised that preparation of the plans for the replacement weir are in progress. It's consultants have completed 50% of scour analysis. Survey work will be completed be completed by next week. The plans might be ready for approval next week.
- (c) Willacy County Drainage District No. 2: Continuing ditch mowing. Overall system in good shape. Report of status of Willamar Lateral improvement project presented.

7.2 Attorney:

- (a) 2022 Eminent Doman Report (for calendar year 2021). Has been submitted.
- (b) May 2022 Election. The Notice of Deadline for file for Place on the Ballot will be posted on or before the December 20 posting date.
